

Student Dress Regulations

I.) Normal School Day

The stipulated school uniform must always be worn;

Team uniform such as that of Red Cross Youth Unit and Girl Guides may be worn when team meetings or activities are held.

II.) Swimming Gala / Sports Day

i.) Members of the Students Union must wear the complete P.E. uniform when entering the venues with flags.

ii.) Members of House may wear costumes during cheerleading competition or performance. Complete P.E. uniform must be worn after the performance before students leave the venue.

iii.) Students staff must wear the complete P.E. uniform as well as their work permit.

iv.) Team uniform must be worn by team members during duty hours.

III.) House Activity Day

Complete P.E. Uniform must be worn. According to present practices, House members may wear their own customized House t-shirt if approved by teachers in charge.

IV.) Wide-life Learning Activities

i.) Outdoor Activities: P.E. uniform or school uniform must be worn depending on the request of teachers in charge.

ii.) Indoor Activities (e.g. concerts, museum visits): Students must adhere to the dress regulations on normal school days.

V.) One-day or Multi-day Educational/ Training Camp

i.) Complete P.E. uniform or casual wear may be worn depending on the requirements of teachers in charge. Casual wear must be tidy and match the identity of students. No shorts or slippers are allowed. Make-up or hair-colouring is forbidden as well.

VI.) Christmas Party/ Dress Casual Day

Students must adhere to the General Dress Regulations. Casual wear must be tidy and match the identity of students. No shorts or slippers are allowed. Make-up or hair-colouring is forbidden.

VII.) Other School Days

i.) School activities, out of school services or inter-school competitions/ performance

Complete school uniform, P.E. uniform, team uniform or casual wear may be worn according to the requirements of teachers in charge.

ii.) Additional classes/ tutorials during weekends or holidays

Students must adhere to the Student Dress Regulations. No shorts or slippers are allowed. Make-up or hair-colouring is forbidden.
